ORGANISATION	SLA VALUE £	SUMMARY OF THE PURPOSE OF SLA
Citizen Advice (FODCA)	£86,275.00	To provide advice services from Cinderford, Coleford, Newent and Lydney together with outreach services in the Forest of Dean District where need is identified.
Forest Voluntary Action Forum (FVAF)	£19,089	To provide a comprehensive voluntary and community sector support and development service and to act as a volunteer brokerage. To help to find new volunteers for organisations both constituted and non-constituted, giving support to individuals into new volunteering opportunities.
Gloucestershire Rural Community Council (GRCC)	£6,026	To provide support to community groups/projects in terms of giving funding advice, enabling groups to become funding ready, advice on gathering evidence of need, project scoping and development, support in bid composition and checking; and progressing other income generation ideas to make groups more sustainable and less grant dependant.
Artspace	£9,731	To provide a wide range of arts activities to people of all ages and abilities resident in the Dean.
Age Concern	£7,641	To contribute towards the provision of a hot meal service to luncheon clubs across the district and to individual older and vulnerable people living in the Forest of Dean, as well as providing a Befriending Service which supports older and vulnerable people in the district to live independently, feel connected and reduce social isolation.
CANDI youth Café	£6,342.96	A contribution towards the core running costs of the Youth cafés - to provide youth café/drop-in facilities and a range of services to young people aged 11 to 25 in the Dean.
