



CSP COMMUNITY GRANT AWARDS 2017-18

The Community Safety Partnership has received a budget of £7,300 from the Police Crime Commissioner (PCC) to be spent on community safety projects within the Forest of Dean which are aligned with the PCC 6 priority areas (Accessibility and Accountability, Older but not overlooked, Young people becoming adults, Safe days and nights for all, Safe and social driving and Safer Cyber).

The maximum award will be £500 per project. Each award must have match funding. This grant will be made available until March 2018 or until all funds are allocated – they will be allocated on a first come basis.
