

Community Grant awards 2019

One off grants are awarded annually by the Community Engagement team to local community groups. They are aimed at *building the capacity* of the community rather than directly delivering services and there should be clear outcomes that are of benefit to the community. Each group awarded a grant should be able to clearly demonstrate that there is local value and leadership and demonstrate its importance to the community.
