

## Forest Youth Activities Fund 2017-18

### Projects Funded – Round 1



This money is being awarded by Forest of Dean District Council and Gloucestershire County Council. The Forest Youth Activities Fund is designed to help provide activities in the Forest of Dean District area that make a positive difference to young people, and to support young people to make decisions, to give grants and to lead projects.

The time period for which funding is given is up until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018. Final decisions are made by Officers and Elected Members of Forest of Dean District Council and Forest Voluntary Action Forum (FVAF), informed by consultation with young people across the district.
