



NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

**FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT COUNCIL
LYDNEY Footpath No FLY87 (Part) – DIVERSION
(at Crump Farm, Lydney GL15)
PUBLIC PATH ORDER 2021**

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14

On 3 November 2021 Forest of Dean District Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the order as made is TO STOP UP the entire width of that length of LYDNEY Footpath FLY87 running from OSGR OS 6449/0363 (Point A) in an east north-east direction for approximately 189m to OSGR OS 6466/0369 (Point B) as shown between Points A – B on the plan attached to the Order and CREATE a new Footpath with a unenclosed width of 2m running from OSGR SO 6449/0363 (Point A) in a south-easterly direction for approximately 17m to OSGR SO 6450/0362 (Point C) then in an east north-east direction for approximately 163m to OSGR SO 6465/0367 (Point D) and returning in a generally northerly direction for approximately 30m to meet the existing route at OSGR SO 6466/0369 (Point B) as shown between points A – C – D – B (total length approximately 210m).

This order comes into force on the date on which the Gloucestershire County Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date on which the Notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of schedule 14 to that Act.
