

## Homelessness prevention strategy 2012 - 2017 (review 2016): Gold standard statistical compiler

The Statistical Compiler set up by the National Practitioner Support Service (NPSS ) is designed to assist local authorities put the Housing Options/Prevention and assessment services into the context of the local operating environment. The Stat. compiler will also help the authority review and update the Homelessness strategy by providing a range of information that can be used to inform its development.

The compiler provides general background information including :

- Population, gender and ethnicity
- Deprivation
- Unemployment and NEETS
- Empty Homes
- Possession claims /orders.
