

Parcel Boundary. This takes account of historic field boundaries and infrastructure corridors.



Contours. These highlight a low lying landscape punctuated by elevated landform.



Public Rights of Way (PRoW). These are valuable features within the area that promote activity and tourism. They also provide important Green Infrastructure corridors.



The A48 is the primary road corridor in the area.



The Gloucester to Newport railway line crosses the area. Chepstow is the nearest station.



Grade 2 listed structure.

Landscape Features:

- Arable and pastoral field network and active farmland;
- No development within the parcel;
- Hedgerow field boundaries, tree belts and woodland;
- Gently sloping landform;
- Minor watercourse present;
- Public footpath present;
- No historical built environment within the parcel;
- Former railway infrastructure present on the eastern boundary of the
- A48 and railway transport corridors on remaining boundaries; and
- Sedbury Lane crosses the parcel.

Visual Receptors:

- Residents within Tutshill to the west;
- Public footpath users;
- Farm workers;
- Road users: and
