**Landscape Features:**

- Army barracks and associated services;
- Scattered dwellings;
- River Severn present to the south and east. The River Wye is present to the west of the parcel;
- Hedgerow and woodland is present to much of the barracks boundary;
- Landform is generally a plateau that falls away at the edges into estuary;
- Limited public footpath presence. Present in the south of the parcel;
- Listed structures present within the parcel, The old Severn Bridge is Grade 1 listed; and
- Road corridor present within the parcel for access. The M48 crosses the parcel but access to it is not provided within the parcel.

**Visual Receptors:**

- Residents of dwellings within the barracks;
- Residents of dwellings adjacent to the barracks;
- Public footpath users;
- Workers at the barracks;
- Road users; and
- Rail users.
