WOOLASTON Footpath FWO70 (Part)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

Deadline for comments : 18th December 2024

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119
AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 6

The above Order was made on the 3rd September 2024. The effect of the order as made is:

TO STOP UP that length of public footpath numbered FWO81 in the parish of Woolaston that commences at a point marked A at ST 5716 9895 in a south westerly direction for 449 metres to a point marked B at ST 5750 9875 and of undefined width as shown between Points A - B on the plan attached to the Order.

And

TO STOP UP that length of public footpath numbered FWO70 in the parish of Woolaston that commences at a point marked B at ST 5716 9875 in a southerly direction for 15 metres to a point marked C at ST 5750 9873 and of undefined width as shown between Points B - C on the plan attached to the Order.

AND CREATE a length of footpath of 2 metres unenclosed width that commences at the point marked A at ST 5716 9895 running along the field boundary in a easterly direction for 216 metres to the point marked D at ST 5737 9894 continuing in a north-north-easterly direction for 52 metres to the point marked E at ST 5739 9899 continuing in a south westerly direction for 154 metres and joining the existing footpath (WOOLASTON footpath FWO 84) at the point marked F at ST 5754 9893 as shown between points A – D – E - F on the plan attached to the Order.

Please quote “WOOLASTON Footpath FWO81”. Please state the grounds on which any representations are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if so made are withdrawn, Forest of Dean District Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
